### What is Beyond the Page?

- **Beyond the Page** is a permanent endowment held and managed by the [Madison Community Foundation](#) that annually funds humanities programming in all Dane County libraries- *forever*.
- **Beyond the Page** began in 2011 with a 350,000 challenge grant from the [National Endowment for the Humanities](#). Every Dane County library went on to raise \$10,000 towards this fund, which now holds 1.5 million dollars.

### How does my library get involved in a Collaborative Grant?

- Write a Collaborative Grant
- Talk with you library director and BtP library liaison. Both should receive emails about possible BtP grants that are in the works.

### If I have questions about the Collaborative Grant I'm involved in, who do I contact?

- Contact the Library Lead for your grant

### Who is in charge of contacting the presenter?

- The Library Lead will contact the presenter initially and 2 weeks before the event. The Library Lead will contact you to confirm details.

### What happens if my presenter doesn't show up?

- Contact their cell number (found on the grant application)
- Let your Lead Library know that they didn't show up

**Who pays the presenter and when do they get paid?**

- The Library Lead is responsible and will contact presenter about payment
